As we know Tenzin Tsundue was arrested in Kullu on the morning of 3 August (as per information available). He managed to get released from Kullu police's arrest. But as soon as he moved out from there, he was again arrested and now he is in Mandi police station. Tomorrow morning he will be produced before SDM of Mandi at 10 in the morning. This is clear case of harrasement. There is absolutely no ground and no cause for arresting him. Tenzin Tsundue called me two times from police station and Lawyers from HRLN-Himachal are trying to secure legal representation for him from Mandi. One lawyer from Mandi named Advocate Deshraj has been approached to represent Tenzin Tsundue tomorrow. When Tsundue called me, he sounded very unhappy on such illegal harrasment and has made up his mood to go to the Supreme Court or High Court for challenging such arbitrary exercise of power by the police and administrative authorities.
